Religious Education Report
May 2022

Evening Religion-We did take the ARK test on April 18th, and I came in on April 20th to help with makeups. We had all but 3 able to take their test before the deadline to return the tests. Notice came Friday, the 6th for checking all info recorded was correct.

Final class was May 2nd. We chose to finish as the children's schools were getting into play practice, concerts, award ceremonies, not to mention spring sports. On May 2nd we had a beautiful May Crowning, with only 1 student missing. Families came and we had a number of parishioners join us. After the service all were invited to the Hall for treats, including the parishioners.

Registration has begun. I ask parents to let me know especially if not returning. Inventory has started, books were ordered and have arrived. We received a 40% discount on price and shipping.

Currently, all students are returning. We will not have a regular 8th grade class unless new students register. Because of Deacon Bob leaving last year and Mrs. Rabe taking over 8th, Father and I chose to move the two 7th we had to 8th and let them be confirmed. At present, I will take over Confirmation prep in the Evening. At present, we know we will have a Villa student with us for Confirmation.

Next Year- At present we are looking at August 22nd being our Introductory night. I will be mailing registration forms and tentative calendars in about 2 weeks. Fees will stay the same since I was able to order our books with the 40% price reduction. Fees won't be due until August.

At present Rose Miller, Mike Witt, Adam Feinauer, and Karen Rabe are returning. At present, I will be looking for volunteers for grade 3, and 6. Our 1st grade teacher hasn't fully committed yet. I will be reaching out to two previous young people who had to step out due to college classes. We do have a couple 8th graders asking to come back to help.

Pre-School & Liturgy of the Word – I will start putting out requests for volunteers this summer. We would like to get those started again.
