Bus News: Bus forms are due tomorrow (8/12/22) at noon. If your child(ren) plans to ride the bus to and/or from school, please complete this <u>bus form</u>. If your child(ren) does not need bus transportation then you do not need to complete the form.

Cafeteria Meal Accommodations Form: If your child has special dietary needs regarding lunches served at Saint Agnes, please complete <u>this form</u> and return it to the school office. Once it is received, the School Food Services Director in the Diocese will set up an appointment to meet with you.

Cafeteria News: The cafeteria will still be using the k12paymentcenter.com for lunch accounts. To deposit money you can either send a check to school (clearly marked in an envelope for the cafeteria) or deposit funds directly online. If you register for an online account, you will be able to view lunch purchases and set up alerts so you get an email when funds are low. If you need your child's student ID to create an account, contact the cafeteria or Mrs. Sucher in the office.

Gym uniforms: Students must wear the gym uniforms sold through the school office. Gym shorts/sweatpants bought at other stores are not part of the dress code. If you need to order anything, send in this <u>order form</u> to the office. Thanks.
