Details for those interested:

- Team practice begins in August with the league starting near the end of August.
- Season is usually 8-9 weeks pending weather and playoff matches.
- Matches are held at Florence World of Golf and typically average about 2 matches a week.
- Great way to have kids learn the game and others to sharpen skills.
- Parent volunteers are needed. Great way to earn service hours and be outside.
- Cost is \$135.00 per player

Shirts are provided for the U6 program. Uniforms for the recreational program must be purchased during the registration process (if needed). Late registrations are not guaranteed and cost \$10 more per player. Player moves after teams are set cost \$10 per move.
