1. Log in to your account on the K12Payment Center website. (<https://www.k12paymentcenter.com>)
2. Navigate to the recurring payment setup screen.
3. Locate the scheduled payments associated with your account.
4. Delete the scheduled payments.
5. By deleting the schedule payments, you will effectively disable the recurring payment feature.

We understand that this may require a few minutes of your time, but we assure you that it is essential to prevent any further recurring payments from being processed. Thank you for your prompt action.

Summer lunches: As summer approaches, we want to make sure that all children in our community have access to nutritious meals, even when school is out. We are excited to let you know about the USDA Summer meals for Kids Site Finder at www.fns.usda.gov/meals4kids. This website allows you to find nearby sites where your child can receive free meals during the summer months. These sites are available in Boone County, Campbell County, Harrison County, Kenton County and Mason County, and will operate from June 2, 2023, to July 28, 2023. To find a nearby site, simply visit www.fns.usda.gov/meals4kids and enter your zip code or address. The site will provide you with a list of locations and mealtimes, as well as any eligibility requirements. It is important to note that these meals are available to all children under the age of 18, regardless of income or eligibility for reduced-price school meals. We encourage you to take advantage of this program to ensure your child receives nutritious meals throughout the summer.
