**Job Descriptions:**

**Cafeteria Managers**

Daily responsibilities include managing the cafeteria, supervising staff, ensuring compliance with the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and state health and food safety standards, overseeing food preparation, and maintaining a clean and organized environment.

**Food Prep Staff**

Responsibilities include assisting with food preparation, such as cutting vegetables, portioning food items, and assembling trays or lunch packages according to guidelines.

**Cooks**

Responsible for cooking and preparing meals following established recipes, ensuring the quality, taste and presentation of the food served.

**Servers**

Responsible for serving meals to students in an efficient and friendly manner, maintaining portion control, and ensuring compliance with food safety regulations.

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
