FROM THE ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL

Dear Parents.

Safety is a priority at Saint Agnes School, and today we practiced our lockdown and evacuation drill with students and staff. With the assistance of the Fort Wright police, the students followed the directions of their teachers and everyone was accounted for when meeting at our rally points. We continue to pray that we will never use this plan, but we're prepared if necessary.

Along with Kenton County and six diocesan schools, we coordinate to provide an organized response if we ever do need to evacuate the building for any reason. Parents will be notified by the school's message system and students and staff will be transported by bus from the rally points to Lakeside Christian Church located at 195 Buttermilk Pike, Lakeside Park. This is the site of the Family Reunification Center for emergency student pick up. Once there, a team will direct parents to follow the process to reunite them with their child(ren).

Every family is getting a safety magnet for your refrigerator that has the location listed. Please check your child's backpack for it today! If you need an additional magnet, contact the school office.
