

4th Grade Summer Reading

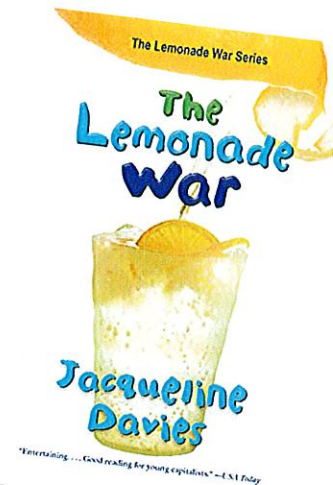
(for students entering 4th grade)

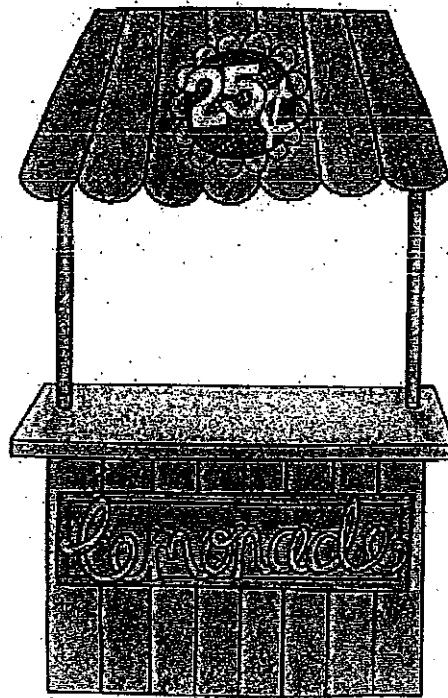

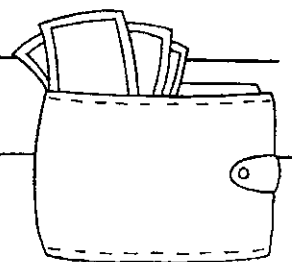

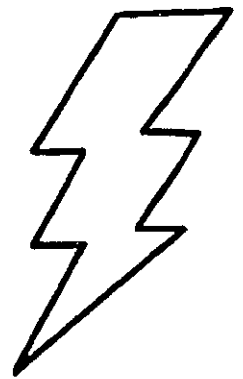
